

## AI Transparency Policy

SolaraCloud AI LLC — SolaraIMPACT Platform

Article 50, EU AI Act (Regulation EU 2024/1689)

Version 1.0 | Effective: March 2026

### SECTION 1: PURPOSE

This AI Transparency Policy establishes SolaraCloud AI LLC's obligations and commitments under Article 50 of the EU AI Act (Regulation (EU) 2024/1689) with respect to transparency toward users of the SolaraIMPACT platform. It applies to all users accessing SolaraIMPACT, including users located in or whose data is processed in connection with the European Union.

### SECTION 2: LEGAL BASIS

Article 50(1) of the EU AI Act requires providers of AI systems intended to interact directly with natural persons to ensure those systems are designed and developed in such a way that the natural persons concerned are informed they are interacting with an AI system.

Article 50(4) requires that AI-generated synthetic content be marked as artificially generated or manipulated in a machine-readable format and detectable as such.

### SECTION 3: TRANSPARENCY DISCLOSURES

#### 3.1 Platform-Level Disclosure

SolaraIMPACT is an AI-powered platform. The AI nature of the platform is central to its value proposition and is prominently disclosed:

- In product marketing and all sales materials
- In the Terms & Conditions (Section 11.4 — AI-Specific Disclaimer)
- In the Privacy Policy (Section 5 — Use of AI Technologies)
- In the platform onboarding flow
- Via persistent UI indicators within the platform interface

#### 3.2 Output-Level Disclosure

All content generated by SolaraIMPACT AI modules is:

- Labeled within the platform interface as AI-generated content
- Accompanied by a notice that professional review is required before external use
- Stamped with module name, generation timestamp, and AI provider attribution in job records

#### 3.3 Required UI Disclosures

The following disclosures must be implemented and maintained in the SolaraIMPACT platform interface:

Location	Required Disclosure	Format
Job output pages	"This content was generated by AI. Review before use."	Visible banner or footer label
Platform dashboard	"SolaraIMPACT is an AI-powered platform."	Persistent header/sidebar element
Onboarding flow	Full disclosure of AI nature, LLM providers used, and data handling	Onboarding modal/screen
Terms & Conditions	AI disclaimer and output advisory notice	Section 11.4 (existing)

### 3.4 Module-Specific Disclosure

Each module output page must display:

- The AI model(s) used to generate the output
- A timestamp of generation
- A notice that outputs are AI-generated and advisory in nature

## SECTION 4: AI-GENERATED CONTENT MARKING (Article 50(4))

### 4.1 Machine-Readable Marking

SolaraIMPACT implements the following technical measures to mark AI-generated content:

- Job records in the database include metadata fields: ai\_generated: true, model\_provider, model\_name, generation\_timestamp
- API responses for job outputs include AI attribution metadata in response headers and body
- Exported content (where download is supported) includes AI-generation attribution in document metadata

### 4.2 Human-Readable Marking

All AI-generated outputs displayed in the platform UI include visible labeling identifying the content as AI-generated.

## SECTION 5: INTERACTION WITH LLM PROVIDERS

SolaraIMPACT integrates the following AI model providers, all of which maintain their own Article 50 / transparency compliance:

## SECTION 6: EXEMPTIONS NOT CLAIMED

SolaraCloud AI LLC does not claim any exemption from Article 50 transparency obligations, including the exemption available where the AI nature of the system is obvious from context. While the AI nature of SolaraIMPACT is indeed obvious, SolaraCloud AI LLC applies full transparency disclosures as a matter of best practice.

## SECTION 7: STAFF RESPONSIBILITIES (AI Literacy — Article 4)

All SolaraCloud AI LLC staff involved in the development, deployment, customer success, and sales functions of SolaraIMPACT must:

- Understand the AI nature of SolaraIMPACT and be able to explain it to customers
- Be aware of the EU AI Act's transparency requirements and SolaraIMPACT's obligations thereunder
- Be able to direct customer queries about AI transparency to this policy and to [privacy@solarcloud.ai](mailto:privacy@solarcloud.ai)

Annual AI literacy briefing for all relevant staff is required. Records of briefings are maintained by the CEO.

## SECTION 8: CUSTOMER (DEPLOYER) OBLIGATIONS

SolaraIMPACT's customers (who are Deployers under the EU AI Act) have their own transparency obligations toward their end users. SolaraCloud AI LLC supports Deployer compliance by:

- Providing this policy and the AI System Technical Description upon request
- Including AI transparency obligations in the Terms & Conditions
- Providing the DPA and sub-processor list, including all AI model providers
- Being available to answer compliance questions at [privacy@solarcloud.ai](mailto:privacy@solarcloud.ai)
